Dear Valued Customer,

As per our previous advisories, Armacup's Bunker Adjustment Factor is adjusted on a quarterly basis.

The BAF for 4th Quarter 2021 is based on the average Platt's Bunkerwire Korea for period June-August 2021 and which is US\$551.85/mt.

As a result, the BAF for Quarter 4 2021 will be (effective Bill of Lading dated October 1st)
