BUNKER ADJUSTMENT FACTOR (BAF)

Dear Valued Customer,

As per our previous advisories, Armacup's Bunker Adjustment Factor is adjusted on a quarterly basis.

The BAF for 1st Quarter 2022 is based on the average Platt's Bunkerwire Korea for period September-November 2021 and which is US\$613.50/mt.

As a result, the BAF for Quarter 1 2022 will be:

Origin: Japan Destination: Australia

US\$ 92.70 per unit for vehicles < 20cbm

US\$ 6.62 per Revenue Ton for Vehicles > 20cbm, Machinery, Construction Equipment & Breakbulk (Effective Passama V2201)

Origin: Japan Destination: New Zealand

NZ\$ 116.80 per unit for vehicles < 20cbm

NZ\$ 9.73 / US \$6.62 per Revenue Ton for Vehicles >20cbm, Machinery, Construction Equipment & Breakbulk (Effective Passama V2201)

Quarter 2 2022:

The Bunker Adjustment Factor for 2nd Quarter 2022 will be advised first week of March and based on the average of Platt's Bunkerwire Korea for Very Low Sulphur Fuel Oil during period December 2021-February 2022.
