Dear Valued Customer,

Going forward, Armacup will base its quarterly BAF calculation on the average Platt's Bunkerwire for Korea, Japan and China in order to be more aligned with the bunker market developments in our trading region.

The average cost of Very Low Sulphur Fuel Oil for period March 2022-May 2022 is US\$918.87/mt.
